After Care

POST-TREATMENT INSTRUCTIONS

After dermalplaning, there may be some redness for some, mild swelling, tenderness, and peeling for a few days. This is normal.

WHAT TO AVOID:

- Do not touch your face after the procedure.
- Do not wash your face or apply additional products to your skin for 24 Hours.
- Avoid strenuous exercise until all redness has gone.
- Avoid extreme temperatures for 24 hours. (sauna, steam-room, sunbed, hot showers)
- Avoid direct sunlight and UV tanning beds for for two weeks.
- Apply sunscreen SPF +30 daily, even if cloudy.
- Return for treatment, every 4 weeks.
- Cleanse and Moisturize with appropriate products between treatments.
